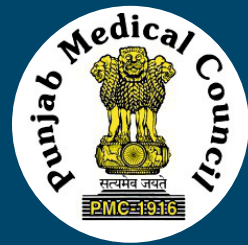

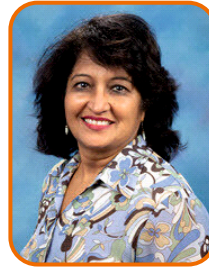

For original studies, the body of abstract should comprise of introduction, material and methods, results and conclusion. For case reports, abstract should be prepared under the following headings: Introduction, case presentation and conclusion.
- The submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific committee. The review process is confidential, and the committee's decision is final.
- Certificate of presentation will be awarded to the presenting author only.
